Imaging Services A new outpatient diagnostic center with stateof-the-art technology including a CT scanner, X-ray machine, ultrasound and bone density (DEXA) scanner provides readily accessible care in a comfortable setting.

Expanded Cancer Care Services Services are being expanded in a space completely dedicated to cancer treatment, recovery and education with a care team including oncologists, a nurse navigator, dietician, social worker and pharmacist.
